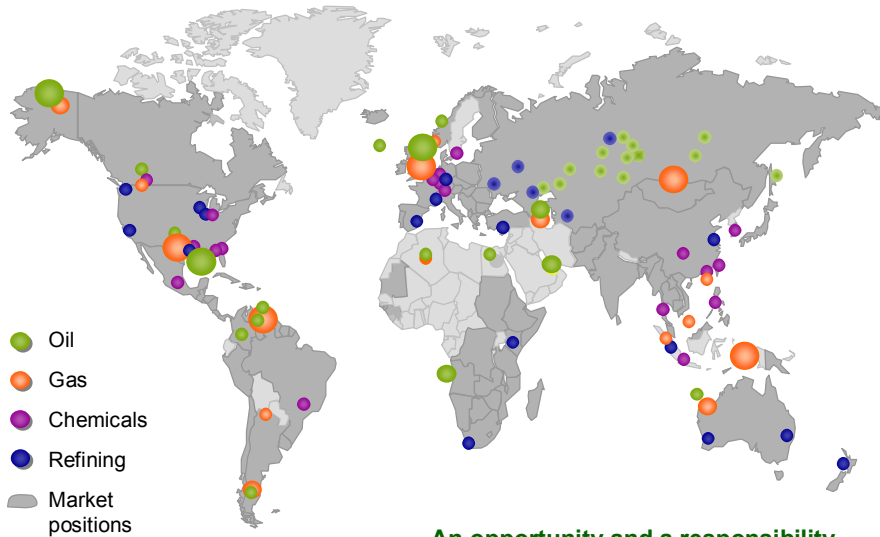

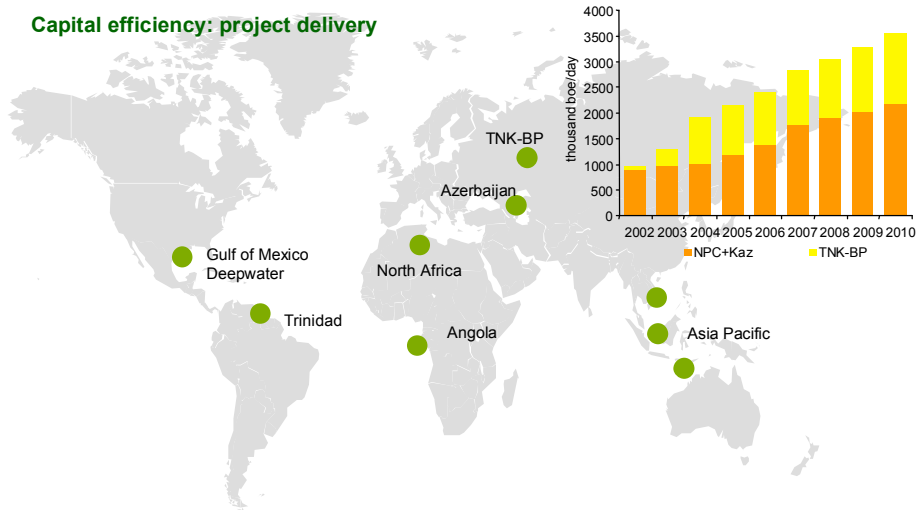

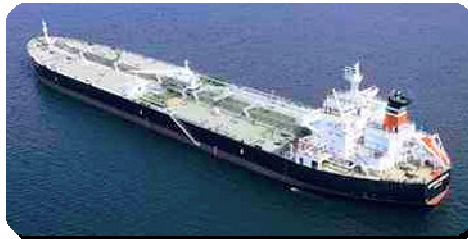

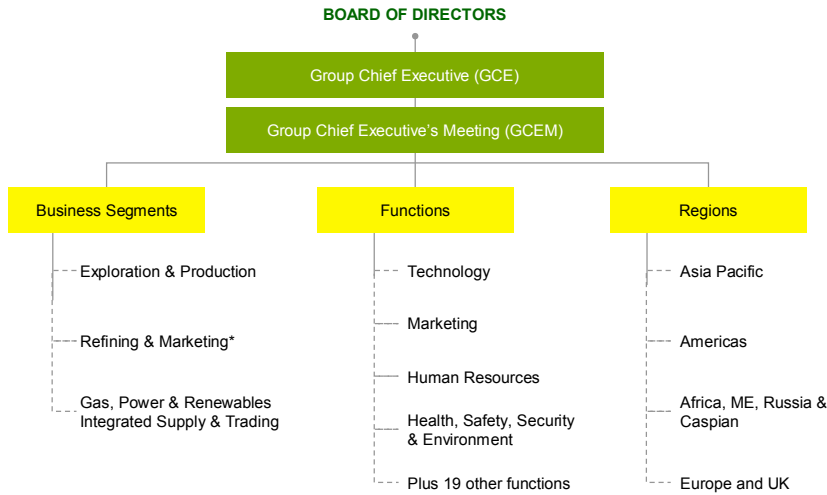
BP Shipping



- **BP Shipping** moved 220 million tonnes of crude and products in 2002, which represents approximately 5% of the world's sea borne oil movements
- Since 2001, 32 new ships have joined the fleet and another 42 are on order for delivery through to 2008
- 85 oil and gas tankers by 2006
- 3,000 voyages a year

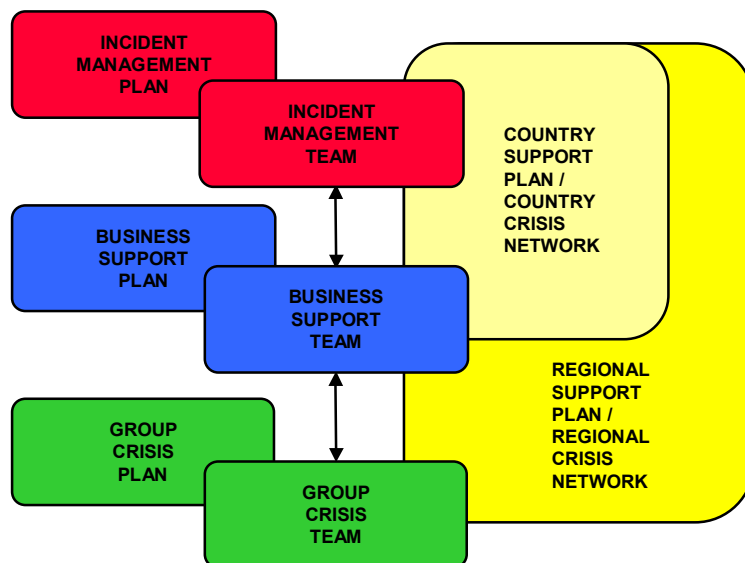


Group's principal structure



* From 1 Jan 2005 Acetyls & Aromatics part of the 'old' Petrochemicals segment became an SPU of the R&M segment

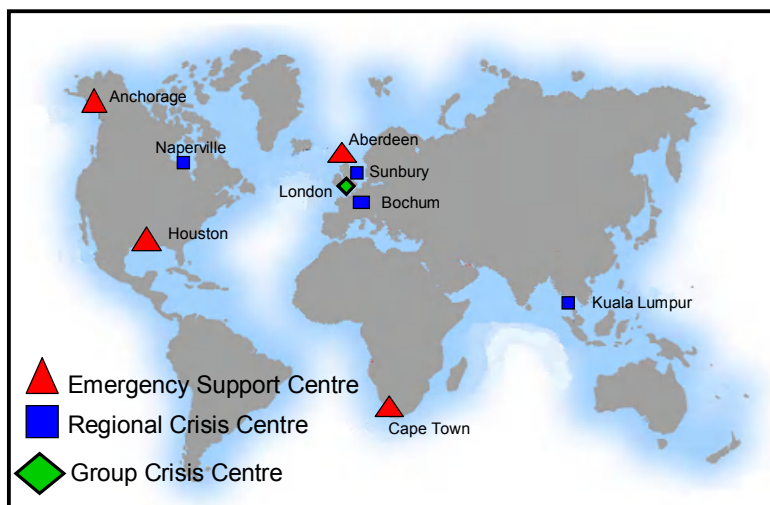
BP Crisis Management Structure
