





































FATE OF THE SHIP

| Natural Break-up | Strip out potential pollutants from accessible areas. Allow wreck to break up under influence of weather, wave action & currents. | |
|-----------------------------------|--|--|
| In situ dismantling | Dismantle wreck in situ for backloading onto barges for transportation to a licensed recycling facility on shore. | |
| Dismantle stern, refloat bow | Stern section cropped & loaded onto barges for transport & recycling, stern separated from bow and cut up in situ, bow refloated & recycled ashore. | |
| Refloat, tow & onshore dismantle | Refloat as complete unit and tow to suitable recycling facility. | |
| Strip/refloat, tow & placement | Clean vessel of all accessible loose materials & pollutants, refloat as single unit and tow to a predetermined deep site for controlled placement on seabed. | |
